- 78. Steelworkers, airline employees, and now those in the auto industry are joining millions of families who must worry about interest rates, stock market fluctuation, and the harsh reality that they may outlive their retirement money.
- 79. After all, four decades of <u>evidence has now shown that</u> corporations in Europe as well as the US are evading the meritocratic hiring and promotion of women to top position-no matter how much "soft pressure" is put upon them.
- 80. <u>His analysis should</u> therefore <u>end any self-contentedness</u> among those who may believe that the global position of English is so stable that the young generation of the United Kingdom do not need additional language capabilities.
- 81. The most drastic, and thoroughly illegal, reaction has been the emergence of Sci-Hub, a kind of global photocopier for scientific papers, set up in 2012, which now claims to offer access to every paywalled article published since 2015.
- 82. There is pressure for change from within the profession, but <u>opponents of change</u> among the regulators <u>insist that</u> keeping outsiders out of a law firm isolates lawyers from the pressure to make money rather than serve clients ethically.
- 83. <u>The force</u> of geographic conditions peculiar to America, <u>the interplay</u> of the varied national groups upon one another, and <u>the sheer difficulty</u> of maintaining old-world ways in a raw, new continent caused significant changes.
- 84. Yet, when one looks at the photographs of the garden created by the homeless, <u>it strikes</u> one that, for all their diversity of styles, these gardens speak of various other fundamental urges, beyond that of decoration and creative expression.
- 85. Under the plan, for example, the agency said it would not prosecute landowner or businesses that unintentionally kill, harm, or disturb the bird, as long as they had signed a range-wide management plan to restore prairie chicken habitat.

- 78. 炼钢工人、航空公司职员,以及现在那些在汽车行业的员工都正在加入那些不得不担心利率、股市波动和退休金不够用这一残酷现实的数百万家庭的行列。
- 79. 毕竟四十年的事实现已表明,不管被施加多大的"软压力",欧洲和美国的企业一直在回避择优录用和提拔女性担任高层职位的做法。
- 80. 有些人可能认为英语的全球地位如此稳定以至于英国的年轻一代不需要获得额外的语言能力; 他的分析应该会结束那些人的自满情绪。
- 81. 最激烈且完全违法的反应是 Sci-Hub 的出现,它成立于 2012 年,类似于一种可以影印全球科研论文的复印机,如今宣称可以提供自 2015 年以来发表的所有付费文章的访问权限。
- 82. 在行业内部存在着改革的压力,但是监管部门中反对变革的人坚称,将外部人士排除在律师事务所之外,可以让律师远离赚钱的压力,从而遵守职业道德为委托人服务。(but 并列句)
- 83. 美国特有的地理条件的影响,不同民族之间的相互作用,以及在这片原始新大陆上维持旧有方式的困难,这些因素引起了重大的变化。(主语是三个由 and 连接的并列名词性短语)

- 86. In his article "How Intelligent Is Intelligence Testing?", <u>Sternberg notes that</u> traditional tests best assess analytical and verbal skills but fail to measure creativity and practical knowledge, components also critical to problem solving and life success.
- 87. At a time when Thomas Piketty and other economists are warning of rising inequality and the increasing power of inherited wealth, it is bizarre that wealthy aristocratic families should still be the symbolic heart of modern democratic states.
- 88. <u>Calls</u> to disassemble all telescopes on Mauna Kea or to ban future development there <u>ignore the reality</u> that astronomy and Hawaiian culture both seek to answer big questions about who we are, where we come from and where we are going.
- 89. <u>Humans are unique</u> in their capacity to not only make tools but then turn around and use them to create superfluous material goods—paintings, sculpture and architecture—and superfluous experiences—music, literature, religion and philosophy.
- 90. As a discovery claim works its way through the community, the interaction and confrontation between shared and competing beliefs about the science and the technology involved transforms an individual's discovery claim into the community's credible discovery.
- 91. But in her new book *Join the Club*, <u>Tina Rosenberg contends that</u> peer pressure can also be a positive force through what she calls the social cure, in which organizations and officials use the power of group dynamics to help individuals improve their lives and possibly the world.
- 92. Fundamentally, the USPS is in a historic squeeze between technological change that has permanently decreased demand for its bread-and. butter product, first-class mail, and a regulatory structure that denies management the flexibility to adjust its operations to the new reality.
- 93. <u>Unhappy parents rarely are provoked to wonder</u> if they shouldn't have had kids, but <u>unhappy childless folks are bothered with the message</u> that children are the single most important thing in the world: obviously their misery must be a direct result of the gaping baby-size holes in their lives.
- 94. To encourage innovation and competition, the report calls for increased investment in research, the crafting of coherent curricula that improve students' ability to solve problems and communicate effectively in the 21st century, increased funding for teachers and the encouragement of scholars to bring their learning to bear on the great challenges of the day.
- 95. Moreover, average overall margins are higher in wholesale than in retail; wholesale demand from the food service sector is growing quickly as more Europeans eat out more often; and changes in the competitive dynamics of this fragmented industry are at last making it feasible for wholesalers to consolidate.

- 89. 人类的独特之处在于,他们不仅有能力制造工具,而且还能反过来使用工具来创作额外的有形物品——绘画、雕塑和建筑——和额外的精神体验——音乐、文学、宗教和哲学。
- 90. 当一个发现声明逐步通过科学界的审查时,与该科技相容和矛盾的观点就会相互作用和对抗,这样就会把个人的发现声明转变为科学界的可靠发现。
- 91. 但是,蒂娜·罗森堡在她的新书《加入俱乐部》中主张,同辈压力也可以通过她 所说的"社会治疗"转化成一种积极的力量。在社会治疗的过程中,各机构及官 员可以利用群体动力来帮助个人改善生活,甚至可能改善整个世界。
- 92. 从根本上说,美国邮政署(USPS)正处于一个历史性的困境之中,一方面是技术变革永久性地降低了对其主要产品——普通邮件的需求,另一方面是监管结构拒绝让管理部门灵活调整其业务以适应新形势。

- 96. But it has already sparked significant controversy, with the United States trade representative opening an investigation into whether the tax discriminates against American companies, which in turn could lead to trade sanctions against France.
- 97. The article is actually quite optimistic, as it outlines a potential solution to this problem, suggesting that an approach (which involves a one-hour, next-to-no-cost program) can close 63 percent of the achievement gap (measured by such factors as grades) between first-generation and other students.
- 98. Precisely because readers from different historical periods, places and social experiences produce different but overlapping readings of the same words on the page—including for texts that engage with fundamental human concerns—debates about texts can play an important role in social discussion of beliefs and values.
- 99. At Tulane University's Tear Analysis Laboratory, <u>Dr. Peter Kastl and his colleagues report</u> that they can use tears to detect drug abuse and exposure to medication, to determine whether a contact lens fits properly or why it may be uncomfortable, to study the causes of "dry eye" syndrome and the effects of eye surgery, and perhaps even to measure exposure to environmental pollutants.
- 100. Young people who are still getting started in life were more likely than older adults to prioritize personal fulfillment in their work, to believe they will advance their careers most by regularly changing jobs, to favor communities with more public services and a faster pace of life, to agree that couples should be financially secure before getting married or having children, and to maintain that children are best served by two parents working outside the home, the survey found.

- 98. 正因为来自不同历史时期、不同地域和有着不同社会经历的读者会对页面上那些相同的文字产生不同但有重叠的解读——包括对涉及人类所关注的基本问题的文本解读,关于文本解读的争议才能在信仰和价值观的社会讨论中发挥重要作用。
- 99. 在杜兰大学的眼泪分析实验室,彼得·卡斯尔博士和他的同事报告称,他们可以用眼泪来检测出滥用毒品及使用药物的情况,确认隐形眼镜戴起来是否合适或者是戴着不舒适的原因,还能用来探究"干眼"综合征产生的原因和眼部手术的效果,也许甚至还能用来测量与环境污染物接触的情况。
- 100. 该调查发现,比起老年人,那些仍然处在生活起跑线的年轻人会更优先考虑他们在工作中的个人成就,更加认同通过定期换工作来推进个人职业生涯,更喜欢拥有较多公共服务的社区和节奏更快的生活,更坚信夫妻在结婚或者抚育孩子之前应该有经济上的保障,更主张父母双方都在外工作才能给孩子提供最好的生活。
